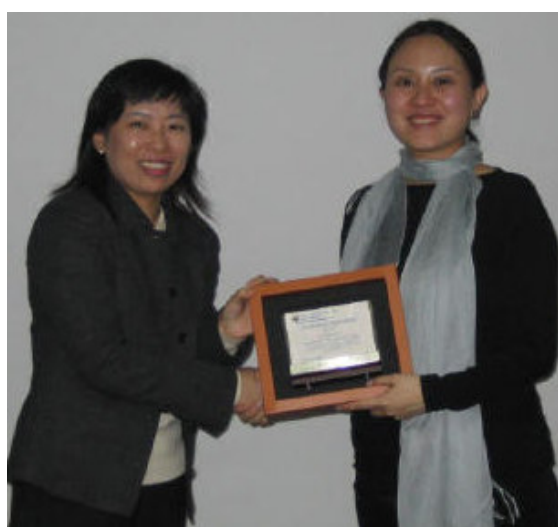




## Academic Meeting on Relief Services in Tsunami-affected Area
