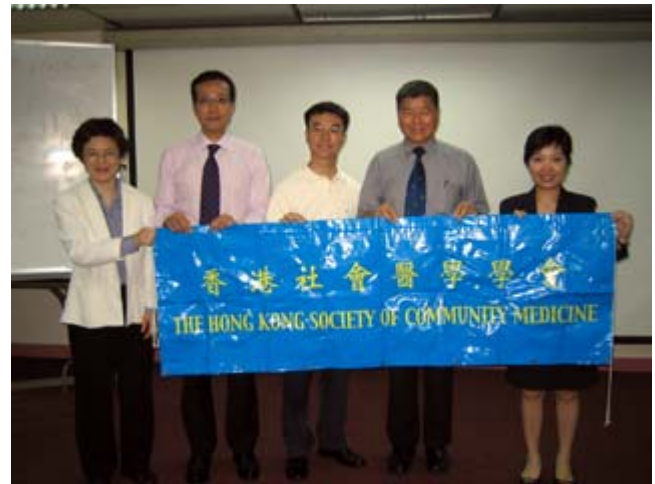
### Disease prevention and control from the Chinese medicine perspective
