Health Care Financing Policy in Hong Kong Past, Present and Future

Abstract

In this talk, Dr LEUNG first introduced the key dimensions of health financing in terms of sources of health finance, fund/risk pooling and provider payment methods. He then reviewed the architecture of Hong Kong Domestic Health Accounts, externally referenced to the OECD accounting system, and what they told us about the historical and current state of the health system. Finally, He gave a brief summary of recent health sector reform proposals and gave an opinionated view of towards where and how our health system may be evolving.
